I am writing to you on behalf of the Assassination Records Review Board, an independent Federal Agency established pursuant to the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act, 44 U.S.C. § 2107 (Supp. V 1994). The Review Board, whose members are appointed by the President and confirmed by the Senate, is charged with the responsibility of collecting records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. The Review Board is not seeking to reach any conclusions regarding the assassination, but is primarily concerned with identifying, clarifying, locating, and making available assassination records.

We are contacting you in regard to your services as medical illustrator for the House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA) during the late 1970s. (By definition, all records created by previous official investigations into the death of President Kennedy fall under the purview of the JFK Act.) We would like very much to discuss with you the details of your role as medical illustrator for the HSCA.
