OBSERVATIONS/TESTIMONY ABOUT THE PRESIDENT:

- A large defect in the occiput...in the right occipital-parietal area. . .There appeared to be bone loss and brain loss in the area (he did not notice any holes below the occiput) . . .saw the wound of entry in the throat and noted large occipital wound -- from *Warren Commission Deposition*.
- The wound which you marked...I never saw and I don't think there was such a wound. I think that was simply an artifact of copying Zapruder's movie...The only wound I saw on President Kennedy's head was in the occipitoparietal area on the right side -- Commenting in writing to researcher Wallace Milam (4/14/80) on the large wound on the top and right side of the head in the Zapruder film.
- The only thing I would say is that over the last twenty-eight years, I now believe the head wound was more forward than I first placed it. More to the side than to the rear -- *To Gerald Posner*.
- The wound, I still maintain, as occipitoparietal...at the time of the surgery itself, we could see a large hole in the occipitoparietal area...the outer portion of the occipital area and part of the parietal area of the skull. I have not changed my mind. The review of the autopsy findings at the National Archives 25 years after the injury merely reinforces my statement which I gave the Warren Commission. I told them there was a 7 cm. (at least) hole in the occipitoparietal region -- *To Brad Parker* (3/4/95)
