 - -For how long did he take photos?
 - -Duration: 30 min? 1 Hour? All night?
 - -When did he start? Finish?
 - -What did he say about the people and events at the autopsy?
 - -Did he see John Stringer/Floyd Riebe or any other photographers taking pictures at the autopsy?
 - -Prosectors/Doctors?
 - -Others? (How many in room/who?)
 - -Atmosphere in morgue/Behavior of others/Autopsy procedures
