Dear Mr. President:

I have the honor of informing you, in accordance with the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, that the Assassination Records Review Board has made additional formal determinations concerning the public disclosure of Executive Branch records at its meeting on July 10, 1996.

Enclosed is a list of the determinations that the Review Board has made. These decisions were premised on several factors including the historical interest in the documents and the absence of evidence that the release of the information would cause harm to the United States or to any individual.

Under the JFK Act you are provided 30 days to make a final decision with respect to disclosure of thes records. You are invited to send your representative to the Review Board to examine our copies of the documents for which determinations have been made and to discuss the determinations with my staff.
