Thank you for your letters dated July 22, 1995 to individual members of the Review Board regarding records relating to the autopsy of President Kennedy. I am responding to you on behalf of the Review Board.

Please be assured that the Review Board is committed to ensuring the broadest possible release of records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. Although it is not our responsibility under the law to answer the questions that remain concerning the assassination and its aftermath, it is our duty to do our best to find all of the remaining records and secure them at the National Archives so that the public has full access to them. The Review Board will be reviewing for release all House Select Committee on Assassination records which are not publicly available. The standards of disclosure provided for under The President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act will be applied.

Again, thank you for taking the time to write and for providing the Review Board with copies of your manuscript. I have taken the liberty of adding your name to our mailing list to ensure that you are kept apprised of the Review Board's work. In addition, I have enclosed a fact sheet on the Board.
