In response to your telephone call, I am faxing to you the highlighted relevant parts of the Archives media advisory and the Review Board news release. Both of them point out that the documents being made available today have been previously available with redactions.

The only documents that are specifically referenced in the Board news release are the ones about a "well-known Warren Commission critic" (Lane). As you know, these are the documents made available at our offices. In addition to the news release, I gave you an overview of the other documents on the telephone last night, indicating that the other FBI documents were primarily negative contact reports on informants who said they did not know anything about the assassination. I also indicated that the CIA documents had also been available before, but were now being made available with a few more names released, but nothing of great interest.

Finally, I would note that we did not make any calls on the this document release, we simply put the news release out, keeping this particular document release in the proper context.
