Thank you for your recent letter regarding various issues related to the work of the Review Board. Per your request, I have enclosed the various materials which you have requested.

With regard to the debate between Oswald and others on August 21, 1963 in New Orleans, my understanding is that this was a radio debate (not a television debate) on William Stuckey's WDSU radio program which was called "Conversation Carte Blanche." According to the National Archives audio/visual inventory, the audio tape of this radio debate is part of the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection and available to researchers. In addition, the Archives lists in their inventory a sound film showing Oswald at the WDSU studio after his radio appearance.

Thank you for your continuing interest in the work of the Review Board.

We will send you additional information regarding the New Orleans hearing when it becomes available.
