Subject: Suggested Talking Points on FBI Release

- 1. This release is another important step towards fulfilling the mandate of the 1992 law requiring government agencies to open up their JFK files.
- 2. This release is important because it helps to round out the record of the assassination.
- 3. Any records related to Cuba and Castro are of interest because they have been part of much of the controversy surrounding the assassination.
- 4. Our role is not to evaluate the records. Our role is to ensure that the American public gets to see the assassination records.
- 5. The Review Board will be reviewing records that agencies do not want to release at this time.
- 6. The Review Board is about openness, not secrecy. The American public can expect more records to be released in the future as the Board continues the review of documents.
