During an inventory of the records which you generously donated to the Review Board, several items of a personal nature were found. Per your request to return any such personal items, I am enclosing them with this letter. Enclosed are:

1. A Father's Day Card signed by Elizabeth;
2. A certificate for Judge Jim Garrison from the American Judges Association;
3. A child's science test dated September 27, 1968; and
4. Documents related to the personal finances of Judge Jim Garrison (8 pages) and one correspondence sent to your father relating to an unnamed movie project (1 page). Total pages: 9; Dates of correspondence: Between March 17, 1980 and September 15, 1982.

Because these items are personal in nature and do not relate to the assassination of President Kennedy, they are being returned to you and your family, consistent with your request.
