Thank you for your letter of April 26, 1995 to the Review Board regarding specific documents which you would like to obtain.

Our records reflect that four of the documents, with the following record numbers: 180-10116-10114, 179-20004-10098, 179-20004-10113, and 179-20004-10108, have been referred by the originator agency to a third agency which either created the record or information contained in the record for review. The President John F. Kennedy Assassination Record Collection Act of 1992 required this action. As a result, these documents have not been reviewed by the Review Board, but I anticipate will be reviewed at some point in the future. At this time, we cannot predict when that will be since it is dependent upon the speed with which the third agency reviews these particular documents. I regret that I cannot be more specific about their status. Please note that documents that are reviewed and ordered release by the Review Board will become part of the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection and available through the National Archives and Records Administration. Our records reflect that the fifth document which you cited, with record number 180-10107-10084, has been recently opened. As noted above, this document should be obtainable from the National Archives by writing to: JFK Liaison, National Archives and Records Administration, Washington, DC 20408.
