This is in response to your letter of June 30, 11995 regarding the JFK Collection document numbered 180–10116–10114. I regret the delay in getting back to you, however, tracking the status of this document proved to be more complicated than originally anticipated.

First, I have enclosed a copy of the document which the Review Board was able to get released. As you can see, it contains only a brief description of Mr. Billy Lovelady, not an interview with him. There was no other document related to Lovelady in the folder which contains various interviews conducted by William Manchester.

Second, the difficulty in tracking the status of the document began with the fact that the record identification form incorrectly stated that the document had been "referred" to a third agency. Ultimately, through discussions with staff persons at the National Archives and the John F. Kennedy Library we were able to clarify the status of the document and provide you with a copy

of it.
