JFK ASSASSINATION RECORDS REVIEW BOARD PLANS VISITS TO BOSTON, LOS ANGELES, MIAMI, NEW ORLEANS

[WASHINGTON, D.C.] An independent federal panel created to oversee the identification and release of all records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, announced today that it will visit Boston, Los Angeles, Miami and New Orleans in early 1995 in pursuit of assassination records.

The Assassination Records Review Board was established by The President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, which was signed into law by President Bush. The five members of the Board were appointed by President Clinton, confirmed by the United States Senate and sworn in on April 11, 1994.

"The Board intends to be aggressive in seeking information about the existence and location of records related to the assassination of President Kennedy," said John R. Tunheim, Board Chair. "We will
