Re: A Couple of Additional Points on Review Board Activities

A couple of additional points I didn't want to bother calling you about, but thought were worth mentioning:

- 1. To date, the Board has voted to publicly release a total of 90% of the redactions which they have seen (593 out of 659 redactions).
- 2. In the third set of documents the Board voted on August 3rd (38 CIA documents dealing with Oswald and Mexico City), the Board voted to publicly release 86% of the redactions. The rest, 14%, were kept closed because they contain sensitive intelligence sources and methods which they determined need to be protected under the JFK Act. But, the redacted information contains no substantive information about the assassination of President Kennedy or Lee Harvey Oswald. Formal notification on this set of documents will be probably be sent to the President by the end of this week. He will then have (30) days from the date of the notification to make decisions on this set of documents.
