Thank you for your letter of May 24, 1995 regarding your interest in certain records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

The Board is committed to ensuring the broadest possible release of records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. Although it is not our responsibility under the law to answer the questions that remain concerning the assassination and its aftermath, it is our duty to do our best to find all of the remaining records and secure them at the National Archives so that the public has full access to them.

On March 23, 1995, the Review Board met with representatives from The John F. Kennedy Library in Boston to discuss assassination records which are at the Library. This preliminary meeting will be followed in the near future by members of the Review Board staff reviewing relevant records. At this point in the process, I cannot comment on the status of any specific records.

Again, thank you for writing to the Review Board. We will add your name to our mailing list to ensure that you are kept apprised of the Board's activities.
