Thank you for your letter of June 5, 1995 regarding the film made by Dallas Cinema Associates (DCA).

The Review Board is in the process of doing a comprehensive review of what photographs and films are already in The President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection, which is housed at the National Archives, and what photographs and films should be added to the Collection. Should the Review Board determine that the DCA film is an "assassination record" and does make it part of the Collection, it would be subject to whatever copyright restrictions that already exist on the film.
