Thank you for your time on the telephone today. The following is my understanding of the arrangements we agreed to:

10 guests rooms are currently reserved under my name, Mr. Thomas Samoluk, with an arrival date of Friday, October 11, 1996 and a departure date of Monday, October 14, 1996.

This block of rooms has been set aside for guests at the Samoluk/Smotrich Wedding. Rooms currently reserved under my name will be given out to people who call the Inn and identify themselves as guests at the Samoluk/Smotrich Wedding. Rooms currently reserved in my name are to be given out to my wedding guests on a first come, first serve basis. Once a guest makes a reservation, the room will be reserved in their name.
