On 6/22/64 [redacted] on a highly confidential basis, furnished the following information

[redacted] conversation occurred on 5/8/64 and was between MARIO RIVA PATTERSON, Counselor, Cuban Embassy, London and an unidentified male visitor, possibly a Colombian.

[redacted] Information is as follows: (S) Cuban

(S) The visitor [redacted] asks if in the case of the assassination of KENNEDY if (?) FOSTER [redacted] was ever in Cuba. RIVA replies in the negative. He says that this man applied for a visa to go to Cuba at the Consulate in Tampico. He was refused a visa. Had he been to Cuba he would have had his passport (K)

VISITOR: "A typical F.B.I. job (RUC)"

RIVA: "A thing (una cosa) of the Imperialists - to kill him in the end - really disgusting - (RUC)"

It is possible that the individual referred to above as FOSTER may have been OSWALD. Above furnished for the Bureau's information (RUC)
