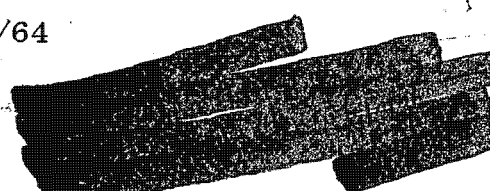

ADMINISTRATIVE

The files of the Mexico City office contain no unreported information regarding the subjects or LILIA PARDO VIUDA DE LARIN.

On 2/24/64, [redacted] Deputy Director, CIA Station, Mexico, D. F., Mexico, stated that the records of that office contained no identifiable information concerning LILIA PARDO VIUDA DE LARIN and no information concerning the subjects in addition to that previously furnished to the Mexico City office. It is noted that all pertinent information furnished by CIA, Mexico, concerning ZHENYA DE MONSHUIK, aka JEANE YLIGON DE MOHRENSCHILDT, who appears to be identical with JEANNE DE MOHRENSCHILDT, has previously been furnished to the Bureau.
