 MADE GILBERTO ALVARADO UGARTE AVAILABLE TO MEXICAN MINISTRY
 OF GOBERNACION (INTERIOR) YESTERDAY AFTERNOON. ALVARADO
 PRESENTLY IN CUSTODY OF MEXICAN AUTHORITIES AND BEING
 INTERROGATED. HE APPARENTLY HAS STUCK TO HIS STORY UP UNTIL
 NOW BUT INTERROGATION CONTINUING.

CIA ADVISES THAT LUIS ECHEVERRIA, ACTING MINISTER OF
 GOBERNACION, COMMENTED THAT HE FOUND ALVARADO'S STORY
 "FASCINATING."

SILVIA DURAN RELEASED BY MEXICANS 6 PM YESTERDAY BUT
 REPORTEDLY CONTINUES TO BE UNDER HEAVY SURVEILLANCE AND SUBJECT
 TO BEING ARRESTED. RESULTS OF HER INTERROGATION NOT YET
 RECEIVED BUT UNDERSTOOD SHE GAVE NO NEW INFORMATION.

PRESS HERE ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT MEXICAN GOVERNMENT HAD
 REJECTED CUBAN DIPLOMATIC NOTE WHICH PROTESTED ARREST OF DURAN
 BY MEXICAN AUTHORITIES ON NOVEMBER 23 LAST. REJECTION STATED
 TO BE BASED ON NATURE OF LANGUAGE USED BY CUBANS IN THEIR NOTE.
