This investigation is predicated on information received from T-1, of known reliability who is an official of the Mexican Ministry of Government (Immigration), to the effect that EDWARD BROWDER, Jr. had been arrested by Mexican Immigration Agents at Mexico City on November 28, 1954.

T-l advised that in view of the fact that the subject was in Mexico illegally at the time of his arrest and was considered to be an undesirable resident, it had been determined that he would be "informally deported" as soon as arrangements for his deportation could be effected at a minimum cost to the Mexican Government. T-l stated that BROWDER had been offered the opportunity of paying his own transportation on any direct airline flight from Mexico to the United States but that his efforts to raise funds for such a purpose had not been successful.

T-l advised that in view of the subject's inability to secure funds with which to pay his own transportation to the United States, he had been informally deported in connection with a group deportation of other United States Nationals. Source stated that subject was transported to the United States border by automobile to Nuevo Laredo, Tamaulipas, where his expulsion to the United States took place to Laredo, Texas, on March 11, 1955.
