- 1. In a private conversation on 4 May 1964 a member of the Frente de Obreros Revolucionario Cubanos (FORC, Front of Revolutionary Cuban Workers) claimed that the following exile groups were conniving to take action against Cuba within the next few months: the Junta Revolucionaria Cubana (JURE, Cuban Revolutionary Junta) the Movimiento de Recuperacion Revolucionaria (MRR, Movement for Revolutionary Recovery); the Ejercito Rebelde (ER, Rebel Army); and the "Alliance" of the Movimiento Revolucionario Popular (MRP, Popular Revolutionary Movement), the Segundo Frente Nacional del Escambray (SFNE, Second National Front of the Escambray, and Alpha 66.
- 2. JURE, the ER, and the "Alliance" were planning to enter Cuba to prepare the groundwork for internal insurrection, while the MRR was to carry out diversionary hit-and-run attacks on the Cuban coasts. Meanwhile, the FORC was building up its own clandestine organization among the workers in Cuba; its aim is to organize sabotage and slow-downs in Cuban industries, thus paving the way for an eventual general strike. FORC claims to have the support of the Confederacion de Trabajadores Venezolanos (CTV, Venezuelan Workers' Confederation) and of the Confederacion Latinoamericana de Sindicatos Cristianos (CIASC, Latin American Christian Trada Union.)
- 3. On 6 May a Cuban exile, who is independent of any exile organization, citimed that all exile groups, including JURE, have the active backing of the United States. JURE was said to have received arms and other material from the United States in recent months.
