For Bureau information, on 2/11/80, Richard N.
Billings was interviewed regarding the requested information
in department memorandum to Director dated 11/21/79, under
Roman numeral Number II. In essence, Billings advised
to the best of his recollection he does not recall
refusing to return a handwritten code list back to
Sergeant David Dale Fore, Madera County Sheriff's Office
Madera, California, that he received from him in the
early part of January or February of 1979. Additionally,
he does not recall making any statements that the codes
were classified government codes and listed as top security.
He then advised that the statements on page 7 and 8 were
not accurate.
