INTERNAL SECURITY - CUBA Central Intelligence At 10:10pm 7-19-64, Agency (CIA), telephonically informed Extra Duty Supervisor that information had been received that captioned aircraft was to be used in an attempt to bomb Cuba on the night of 7-19-64. During ₹a11 CIA was informed that instant aircraft was in the custody of Customs at Bradley Field, Fort Lauderdale, Fla. Notification of the attempted bombing had been received by CIA at 8:40pm 7-19-64, from State Department Operations which in turn had been notified by Federal Aviation Agency. No information was available as to the identity of any person or organization involved in the bombing attempt. Reportedly, the plane was to leave Lantana, Fla. at 9:00pm 7-19-64, pick up two passengers at Opa-locka, Fla., and then pick up two more passengers at Bradley Field, Fort Lauderdale, Fla., where it would also pick up four 100 pound bombs, and proceed to Cuba, Customs, Border Patrol. and Defense Intelligence Agency had been notified, Onone had any additional information re alleged according to As noted above, while furnishing above information, attempted bombing. received word that the aircraft involved had been taken into custouy by Customs at Bradley Field. Customs, Federal Aviation Agency, and Border Patrol have jurisdiction over illegal plane flights over Cuba. requested that any pertinent information developed by the FBI concerning this matter be given to CIA.
