On 2/21/66, information was received from Central Intelligence Agency that its source, [redacted] known to your office, had advised that on 1/26/66, while in Brussels, Belgium, he met a woman who called herself Lisa Armand. She advised [redacted] that she was there for talks with Jacques Grippa, who is the leader of the pro-Chinese faction of the Belgian Communist Party concerning the defense for William Epton. Following [redacted] conversation with Armand, he checked the hotel register where Armand was staying and determined that her passport identification listed her as Mrs. Frank. (S)
