3. [Will contact one or more of the other 16 "prisoner" associates of subject, as listed in enclosure to reBulet (Miami file 62-3573-500), [to determine subject's present activities and evidence of possible agency on behalf of CASTRO government.] (S)(u)

-ADMINISTRATIVE-

The CIA letter of reference advised of 17 individuals, but listed only 16 by name, who were to have participated in the Cuban invasion attempt but who for disciplinary reasons were unable to do so. (S)(u)

On May 10, 1961, CIA, Miami, delivered a similar list to the Miami Office and the seventeenth individual was noted as MARTIN TORRES FORTE, not further identified. (S)(u)

According to CIA Agent [redacted] Miami, these seventeen individuals were kept in the guard house at the training camp in Guatemala as disciplinary cases of routine army nature and were not suspected of pro-CASTRO activities. (S)

Miami file review [on the seventeen individuals, (S)(u) reflected background data on several, generally from INS, Miami, re Cuban political refugees entering the United States. (S)

The only one [of the 17 individuals] identified from Miami files as an alleged CASTRO agent was RICARDO MARTINEZ DE LA CRUZ. (S)
