Dear Sir:

For several years Tuya Cuban Express was favored with your air shipments to Cuba. In 1960, due to the communist take-over, and the imprisonment of my father and me, our operations were discontinued. Today, we are engaged in the struggle against communism through "Comandos L", and I come to ask for your support.

Comandos "L" was created in 1962 by a group of freedom-loving Cubans, most of them businessmen and professionals, with no personal or political ambitions other than the liberation of Cuba. Their efforts and accomplishments were clearly disclosed by LIFE magazine of April 12th, 1963, whose front cover displayed a memorable drawing of the attack on the Russian Ship Baku.

I am convinced that victory over communism can be achieved if we recognize that the international communist conspiracy is waging total war against us, and that the re-establishment of democracy in Cuba is the greatest contribution we can make now to the sacred cause of world peace, a cause for which many members of Comandos "L" have given their lives.

Stand with Comandos "L". Give us your spiritual support and your financial aid now. Your contribution will help provide the solid financial backing needed to wage our war against communism, today firmly entrenched only 90 miles from your shores.
