In accordance with instructions concerning the handling of double agents there are enclosed herewith ten copies each of two separate letterhead memoranda.

These letterhead memoranda have been classified SECRET, in order to protect the identity of a double agent of continuing value to the United States.

The Cuban Intelligence Service (CIS) instructed the double agent to make periodic written reports concerning activities of the anti-Castro organization, COMANDOS L, at Miami, Florida. These written reports were to be photographed for [redacted] in New York City in late September, 1967. Accordingly, these letterhead memoranda set forth the texts of two reports prepared by [redacted] in accordance with these instructions.
