On 2/18/60 CIA advised Bureau via liaison channels that [redacted] Rio de Janeiro (S) Brazil, had received information from unidentified Brazilian officials that captioned subjects are presently in Miami, Florida, attempting to charter a plane to transport arms to an unknown destination in Brazil. These arms are alleged to be for "an unknown Cuban enterprise." (S)

It was further stated one of the subjects is wearing a Brazilian Army uniform and the Brazilian officials are attempting to obtain additional details. CIA has furnished this information to the Bureau of Customs, INS and Secret Service. (S) (u)

Bufiles fail to disclose references identifiable with subjects.

Miami Office is instructed to check with appropriate sources in an effort to identify subjects and determine the purpose of their visit to the U.S. Bureau of Customs and INS should be contacted to determine what, if any, information has been developed regarding subjects' identifications and activities.
