Subject: ALLEGED SOVIET INFLUENCE IN CUBA
INTERNAL SECURITY - CUBA

Reference is made to your letter dated
December 23, 1959, your reference CSCI-3/757,865,
concerning captioned matter. (S)(u)

Our files reveal that the information
set forth in State Department memorandum dated
October 16, 1959, originated with Paul Hickman.
In this connection, the results of our interview
with John Parkhurst Booth were furnished to your
Agency on December 2, 1959, in a memorandum
captioned "Alleged Soviet Influence in Cuba."

With regard to Paul Hickman, our represent-
ative in Paris, France, learned that Hickman, during
an interview with the Swiss Federal Police, admitted
he had furnished false information to your represent-
ative in [redacted] on November 27, 1959.
It is requested that you verify the fact that Hickman
made false statements to your representative. It is
also requested that you advise us if you have any
objection to our furnishing information regarding
Hickman's false statements to the Department of State,
the Atomic Energy Commission, and the military
intelligence agencies. (S)
