OBSERVATIONS:

It is the opinion of the Liaison Agent that CIA does not have a strong foundation for initiating an approach as indicated. The Agency could be on a fishing expedition and we may find it desirable to object to CIA's proposed action in the absence of additional information. We also should bear in mind that the Bureau is free to consider the use of the lift we felt this operation should be handled by the Bureau.

ACT ION:

The above information is being directed to the attention of the Nationalities Intelligence Section. It is suggested that its reply to CIA be transmitted via Liaison.
