On March 16, 1961, Mrs. Jane Roman, Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), furnished the Liaison Agent the enclosed draft of an article which CIA proposes to plant in a leading United States publication, possibly [redacted] (S) The material essentially consists of an attack against the captioned organization and includes some material which has been disseminated by the Bureau to CIA. According to Mrs. Roman, this data will be furnished to some well-known writer not yet selected (S)

She inquired if the Bureau had any objection to the use of its material, which has been noted and bracketed in the enclosure (S)

Mrs. Roman also advised that once arrangements are made to publish the article the Bureau will be given the opportunity to review the final draft before publication. (S)(u)

ACTION:

The above information and enclosure are being directed to the attention of the Nationalities Intelligence Section. The reply to CIA should be transmitted via Liaison. (S)(u)
