An inquiry was received from Laughlin Campbell, Chief of CIA, Paris on March 13, 1964 regarding the captioned individual. Pertinent information in the Paris files was furnished to Mr. Campbell. He indicated at the time that CIA was considering using GIBSON as a source of information or contact. It is noted that GIBSON is presently employed in the headquarters of the new magazine named "Revolution," which is believed to be an outlet for Chinese Communist propaganda. The headquarters of this magazine recently moved from Lausanne, Switzerland, to Paris, France, and details regarding it has been reported separately to the Bureau.
