It is noted that the subject, who was Acting National Executive Secretary of the FPCC, recently left New York and was reported to have gone to Algeria where he was to have worked as a reporter for the Cuban newspaper, "Revolucion" (A)

The committee referred to in this letter is probably the Fair Play for Cuba Committee. LEE is VINCENT TED LEE, whom the subject left in charge of the FPCC when he left and the friends in the Caribbean are in all probability officials of the Cuban Government. TONY is an associate of the subject [redacted] (S)
