In connection with Task Force W efforts to split the Cuban leadership, some time ago we targeted Juanas Gastro Ruz. halfesister of Fidel and Raul Castro Ruz. A number of reports have been received indicating that Juana Castro Ruz opposed the strong communist nature of the Cuban regime and was prepared, at least to some extent, to cooperate with antiregime elements. In May 1962 we reestablished contact with and

and a long time personal

friend of Juana Castro Ruz.

3. On 11, June 1962, on our instructions, proceeded to Havana where she maintained frequent contact with Juana CastrowRuz and other prominent Cuban leaders until l July 1962. She discussed the current regime quite frankly with Juana Castro Ruz and, according to obtained Juama's agreement to provide intelligence on the Cuban political leadership and to work against the Cuban communist regime, short of engaging in activity which might result in direct personal harm to the result in direct personal harm t According to Janana has agreed to proceed to Mexico or the United States in this connection and return to Cuba after discussions with "the Americans".

We are making the necessary arrangements with to have Juana Castro Ruz proceed to Mexico as soon as possible in order that we may attempt a direct recruitment. You will be kept advised of any future developments of importance in this case.
