Interview: Robert Genzman and Harold Leap interviewed Dennis Flynn at his home on June 16, 1978. The interview yielded the following information.

Flynn worked for the FBI from 1934 to 1946, and for the Department of State from 1947 to 1967. From 1953 to 1956 he was Director of Security at the State Department.

Flynn recalls the following procedures for State Department  The State Department's Personnel Office would request clearances from the Security Office. The Security Office would  certify clearance. The Security Office would then grant clearance.
