Propaganda loop in Mexico -

- myself secure office & see unless -
- > from 61 to '63 ran about 600 operations -  
 "projects" - <sup>activities</sup> active - 16 or 17 on-going  
 operations -
- > directed at Cuban target - "most serious  
 ultimate aim of heavy effort on Cuba target  
 but I don't recall that great percentage  
 had anti-Cuban or anti-Soviet bias
- > How many agents handle yourself: "very very  
 few. I met someone [in deep cover who  
 would handle several agents - handled  
 one personally in radio TV loop. - I would  
 meet other but not handle them -
- at least one case officer on outside  
 [in deep cover - someone down in Ted's  
 (Was all assets in Mex City area) So had as I recall.
- > Propaganda assets outside Mexico City
- One assets developed prior to transfer to Mex? Yes  
 [Jayas] - newspaperman - had met in Cuba - went  
 to Mex.
- > Ch. B of P. use assets developed in Hawaii? Yes
- > How often in Mexico - Every 6 weeks, 3 weeks, 5 weeks  
 "fairly frequently"
- How divide responsibility? Next reported to  
 my loop in Wash. He had day-by-day contact?

Why name would come up? It usually came up on any formal project, but I did like to delegate work; But my name must be on many papers

re: Was there a CI rep. in Cuban section - I don't always watch out for it, but no formal program strong on CI - I never really understood what CI was - I think it was characterized as "average" in Cuban section? Probably less than average

America's Special Affairs Staff in Havana that dealt with Cuban matters - Yes - and a special CI section of that staff? Yes. [redacted]

- He probably did visit him in New City. "routine things or a 'special case'" - don't recall - Legat office? - Don't remember how large but large. <sup>11-20</sup>

Relationship between station & Legat office - Yes quite close. Got drop copies of most reports.

Yes, they were interested in Americans in contact with foreign Embassy -

> Don't know if there were routine contact reports forwarded to FBI - To

- only in "interesting cases" it was routine to advise them - such as on Bureau reporting to a foreign embassy

(9) The reason for CIA's report by DHO's first visit was that it was routine

"field traces" would include FBI as well & it would have been routine for the Agency to report who came to the attention - would it have been routine to do more than report?

Yes, if it looked like a recruiting potential -

> Yes, recall during action - re story of a helpline who reported getting \$20 to take message to Cuban Embassy by a Mexican military man.

> Back in June or July '63, info re [all top] in American in contact with Cuban embassy who wanted to defect -

Did not need request from another agency to take action on an <sup>American</sup> in contact with embassy? - No. Yes, could take action without a specific request.

> Did CIA share assets and informant with FBI? I don't know if there were such case.

But there was coordination or surveillance ops who in station resp. for American Communists in Mexico. Maybe Anne (Cruz) (Cruz)

Viola June Cobb - blonde, flew on airplane, track record for getting a lot of beds in Cuba. Had a known sister who had a accident - remembers message about her out of her country [feels she was run out of Wash or Miami. someone would come down to run her]

Care open with hair by or spine with key? don't recall?

De Hoff:

> Warren Comm - 3 or 4 men spent part of the time with the Galt a day. chief of staff

Julia Duran: - About the time of arrival at Mexico. As soon as I started seeing tel. logs. Her name appeared there & there again.

We had no interest when she came to friendly with anyone.

Re Slawson's report: re Duran's affair with Fuchuga - "no one saw her in on this operation"

> At one time we pitched everyone at that Cuba Embassy - she must have been considered -

- Her FBI file would be "very thick"

- Only 3 docs: "that would be very surprising."

> But a trace man would come up with a lot.

I saw Fuchuga 3 times after I left Cuba -

2) in a photograph of Day O'nday in '64

> Wm Scott safe in off? Don't remember but vaguely did remember he had a safe.

- description "could be" her. further report  
not necessarily have gone back to headquarters.

Dispatch # 3715 - a 1 Sept '63

re Jura Calderon's notes - Don't know if she was ever identified - never heard term "domestic exploitation."

Barney Hilbelgo - don't recall from when he was in Mexico but must have been yes, worked with him. He didn't have executive talents, but always <sup>in</sup> solved <sup>the</sup> <sup>law</sup> <sup>problem</sup>. I don't want to say he was crazy, but I was always uncomfortable around him -

- It would have been possible for an agent in Mexico  
to be run out of JFK one station  
without my knowledge - but I would  
have been furious.

#3662 - not aware of it - it's the kind of thing they might have asked Barney Hidalgo to do.

#3665 again - agrees that does indicate a pitch to be made for someone outside of Mexico.

if it was someone from the CIA, there would be something in her 201 file - but possibly it could be run out of a soft file -

> Her no explanation of why Calderon transcript was found in Oswald file and not in her 201 file -

> Re cameras at Cuban Embassy: Still remembers that [Bob Shaw] & I went over <sup>contract</sup> strips of positives of photos at Cuban consulate -

> "stink bomb" operations - There were, I'm sorry to say, some stink bomb operations, but don't recall.

> Re 27 Sept. 63 installation of impulse camera - file review indicates camera functioned for 5 days (2 Sept to 1 Oct.) before malfunctioning -

(He wasn't there ~~on 27th~~ during that time)

NO recollection of what happened to photos from impulse camera -

Public Goodpasture - don't recall of the  
 recommended use of service protocol -  
 re Oct 8th + 11th response re Oswald's having  
 been to Cuban embassy -  
 - why no documents.

Was prior to assassination, another cable <sup>sent to HQ</sup>  
 about Oswald.

if so, I do not recall it. - (Could

It's technically possible & has been done  
 on occasion - by persuading telephone  
 communicators to use tel com system (a Q+A

happened in Mexico - also by telephone

> Went to Cuba in summer of '58 returned  
but went on contract - not staff status -  
- propaganda for Peter Duncan & not for  
Cuba - after that it was ad hoc  
stuff - see that led to ad hoc  
stuff sent out to provincial newspapers -

> meetings of anti-Castro people - but  
there was no reprint in grey -

> remember one meeting with Julio  
Jobo - don't recall - no substantial  
dealings -
