Possibly because of this loosely structured control over JURE, the CIA had the day-to-day activities of the group closely monitored by an individual identified only by the cryptonym, (AMTAUP/1, AMTAUP/2). [redacted]

[redacted] was in frequent contact, ^{especially} with (AMTAUP/2) and ~~and~~ readily confided in him. [redacted] conversations were ^{very} duly transmitted

If the CIA or JURE plans to infiltrate one of their members into the CIA, regarding such subjects as: Ray meeting with Robert F. Kennedy in 1963 (CIA/DDO Ray II Cable to DDCI from JMWAVE, Sept 11, 1963); Ray's negotiations on behalf of JURE (CIA/DDO Ray II, Cable to DDCI for JMWAVE 11 Oct 63) Secret JURE meeting (CIA/DDO Ray III - Dispatch to Chief, Spec. Affairs from CS/JMWAVE 21 Oct 63); Allegations that Gov. of P.R. was purposefully sidetracking an FBI / INS investigation of illegal arms possession by JURE in P.R. (CIA/DDO Ray III, Cable to DDCI for JMWAVE 30 Jan 1964); JURE animosity toward Artime & MRR (Vol VIII ^{cable to DDCI 60} JMWAVE, 3/7/64).

more operations to Costa Rica (p. 9) and established a guerrilla training base in Venezuela. (CIA/DOO Ray Vol XII, Cable to Dir. from SMWAVE, Jan 31, 1964 - Intelligence Info. Cable, Feb. 4, 1964)

Ray began to formulate plans for his infiltration into Cuba in March 1964 (CIA/DOO Ray Vol XII, Cable to Dir. from SMWAVE, Mar 28, 1964) and made plans to turn URE over to Rogelio Pieneros in his absence. (CIA/DOO Ray Vol XIII Memo for Chief, WH Division, Apr 14, 1964 from Alfonso Rodriguez, Subj: My meeting with Ray on 13 April 1964) His plan did not reach fruition and Ray and his group were arrested by the British near Cayo Largo and taken to Nassau for a short detention. (CIA/DOO Vol XIV, Cable to Director from SMWAVE, June 3, 1964). Ray's failure in the face of Ray's infiltration attempt and resultant publicity brought his prestige among the Cuban-exile community to a "near-absolute low point." (CIA/DOO Ray Vol XV, Cable to Director from SMWAVE, 10 June 1964)

In addition to Ray's loss of credibility, holding to his credibility trouble, and the embarrassing revelations by the FBI^{U.S. Treasury} that URE had illegally purchased \$50,000 worth of arms from a California company which were confiscated in a raid on that company in California in May 1964 (CIA/DOO Ray Vol XIV, Memo for Record, May 20, 1964 from Samuel Halpern, Subj: URE purchase of Arms) caused the CIA considerable embarrassment (Ibid) The agency denied knowledge of the arms purchase when queried by Revenue

For these reasons, his background was questioned
by the State Dept & ~~the Miami CIA office~~ (CIA/DOO Ray VOL I, Memo to WH Chief from Acting Chief, WH, 9/27/60, Subj: State Approval to Include Manuel Ray Pueyo into the FRD Complex) and the Miami CIA Office (CIA/DOO Ray VOL I, Cable from MAST to WH/9, 9/29/60) when, in the summer of 1960 he was actively being recruited by the CIA in Havana to become a member of the FRD, a newly formed anti-Castro Organization sponsored by the CIA (cite)

Another episode in May served to compound the problems of JURE. Rogelio Cenobio had ^{obligated} ~~invited~~ \$50,000 of JURE money for the purchase of weapons by an El Monte Calif. ^{arms} manufacturing company ~~to be shipped to Florida.~~ ~~so informed~~ (CIA/DDO Ray XIV, Memo for Record May 20, 1964, from Samuel H. Alpern, Subj: JURE Purchase of Arms.) California authorities ~~wrote~~ ~~the~~ FBI in the course of investigating the mfg. company, asked the CIA if they had any knowledge of this purchase, which was illegal ~~that~~ ^(Oibid) under U.S. laws. Working under the autonomous ^{operations} guidelines, the CIA denied any involvement and advised JURE to make use of one of their L.A. connections to facilitate the shipment outside the U.S. (Oibid)

officials and because of the autonomous nature of its relationship with JURE, did not make any attempt to stop Roemer's investigation (Ibid) this combinat

This combination of events led a special group within the CIA to cancel any monies to Ray until he ceased all activities from the U.S. mainland. (CIA/DDO Ray Vol ~~XVII~~, Memo for Record, 29 June 1964 from Alfonso Rodriguez Subj: Establishment of Base Abroad, Manuel Ray Rivers). A final payment of \$75,000 was made to JURE at the end of 1964 and JURE books were closed at the CIA. (CIA/DDO Ray file Vol ~~XVII~~ Autonomous Operations Operating Plan) (CIA/DDO, Ray Vol ~~XVII~~, Memo for Record, draft, Sept 22, 1964, Alfonso Rodriguez)
