of Mexico, to set up operational bases in the Yucatan at a cost of \$50 -
\$1,000, to sabotage targets in Cuba identified by the U.S. gov't,
and to provide positive intelligence on the activities of Chinese Communist
groups in the Western Hemisphere."

Rothman stated @ Castro had executed 3 of his close friends:
Rogelio Gonzalez; Sori Marin; Efigenio Fernandez.
