## Visit of Cuban Exile Urtiz Espinosa

At request of friend, Valmore Acevedo, Venezuelan Christian ~~Communist~~, Democratic friend, LISTER agreed to meet Espinosa.  
Espinosa statements as follows:

- (1) Opposed BATISTA, opposes Castro  
Not a member of "March 13th" Movement,  
but close to many of its leaders, including Cabello.
- (2) Trained by CIA in Sonsona and Guatemala  
sent to Cuba prior to Bay of Pigs  
Plans to become DCI in May, 1965.
- (3) Early in 1965 Espinosa received request  
from one of his reliable Cuban contacts in Europe  
asking that he come quickly. Espinosa went  
to ~~Europe~~ Miami, obtained false Cuban  
papers, and went to Paris. In the presence  
of the Cuban Club, to France, met one of Castro's<sup>possibly from b  
other fo  
Bard</sup>  
top secretaries who had come to Paris  
for that purpose.

For days of meetings in France, & Spain  
where Espinosa resided illegally, Espinosa was  
informed that there is a plan to  
overthrow the Cuban regime and kill Castro &  
some of the main leaders.

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The plot is led by Cuban and some of the March 13 movement plus (writer believes some military officers.)

They must move more quickly because more and more people learning of the plot and thus growing sick of exposure.

They are anxious to have some coordination or at least consultation with responsible Americans. They ~~feel~~ are not confident that they could win an all-out fight against Castro forces, thinking more in terms of taking control for a few hours killing Castro & his most effective men. They want what if anything the American might do to help when the coup is attempted. They also wished to alert the US Govt as to what was being planned.

The leaders might have turned to Earl Williamson to C/H Madrid, but believe him to be unreliable so Cuban girl sent Madrid sometime ago. Any Castro would fool Williamson. He arranged for her to work with International Rescue Committee and return to Madrid w/ plans of plot.

Hofler asked Loposa to keep go between with reliable American officials. Hofler says min. reliable is Dr. Havana while the upper 1/3 of plotters worth in Spain for whom

Hofler was referred to N.Y. called Office of FBI and asked for NC put in touch with Cuban and reliable men from CIA.

The moss file contains the following information and documents:

① memo for the <sup>Deputy</sup> Chief of Security Research Staff, 14 May 1973 in which a memo dated 28 Feb 1968 is referred to. The referenced memo states that "a verbal report from Dun & Bradstreet recognize moss' long standing 'Mafia' connections. "moss' operation seems to be government contracts for the underworld and probably surfaces mafia money in legitimate business activities. This memo also states that from 1950-53, moss was serving on appointed position with the US Govt, first as an Assistant Administrator in Charge of Public Information, National Production Authority; and then with the Defense Production Administration both with the Dept. of Commerce."

2 - Who's Who in America- entry for moss.

3 - Dun & Bradstreet report dated Sept. 27, 1968. On June 1, 1960 moss merged his activities with Howard Chase Associates, Inc. moss was also Pres. of a wholly-owned subsidiary, Chase & moss, Inc, Wash. D.C. June 1, 1961 parties agreed to demerge with assets returned to respective owners. Settlement negotiations led to litigation. In 1964 - settlement was effected. In 1965 moss served as Asst Director, OEO, with responsibilities ~~asst~~ for public affairs advisor to the White House Conference on Civil Rights.

- ④ A June 29, 1967 Dun & Bradstreet report states that moss is a principal in General International, which is stated to be an Italian Corporation engaged as consultants in economic and business area development, Europe, Africa, & in Asia.
- ⑤ A memo to the file, dated April 1967 re moss. The last approval granted by the Office of Security for moss' use was "a Covert Security Approval dated 7 November 1962" to enable moss' use "by the Political Group of the CA staff."
- 6- memo, date 23 March 1965, states that NE obtained a covert security approval in 1959 and CA in 1962 for moss in the public relations field.
- 7- 30 Nov 1962 - memo - from Political Action Group / Covert Action staff requests any objections to the use of ~~the~~ moss as a public relations advisor.

The file on Joseph Merola contains the following information and documents:

① memo dated 28 Jan 1974 re office of ~~Security~~ file. States that Merola first came to the Agency's ~~at~~ attention in 1961 when he visited Justin F. Gleichauf who was then Chief of the [ ] [ ] Division. Merola said he had info concerning a Brazilian Senator, a close friend and confidant of Che Guevara. It was felt that Merola's reason for contacting the Agency was to ascertain if the Agency would intervene with the Fed. Court to rescind the 25 mile travel restriction. He was informed that the Agency could be of no assistance. Mr. Merola also said he had been engaged in gunrunning in behalf of Castro during the revolt against Batista and had been received warmly by Castro & Camilo Cienfuegos. Merola again contacted the Agency on 20 Nov 1972 informing that he was going to jail for one year. No further contact with Merola.

② A Feb 15, 1964 cable from [ ] reports that 3 people have been arrested for theft of dynamite & illegal possession of explosives. Claiming that they stole the dynamite on behalf of Merola, a CIA agent. "Merola is not a CIA agent but used solely as an informant by IMPALM."

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3. memo of visit to Merola, dated 8 Feb 1961, reports Brazilian Senator story. Merola said that Sam Kay, one of his associates in the Latin American contraband business, told him that the Senator was interested in developing a project whereby large quantities of whiskey would be smuggled into Brazil. (Contacts in Cuba with Castro.) <sup>merola</sup> He was also in contact with Colonel "Johnnie" Abbes, head of the Dominican secret police. Merola also indicated that he is very well acquainted with Antonio de Varona, head of the FRD, and felt that he would be able to provide definite assistance to the Frente should he be called upon. He has a '63' boat available which he would not be adverse to "lending" to his friends."

① Miami Herald article, dated 21 Oct 1969, reported the arrest of 3 men, Eduardo Whitehouse, Jose Roberto Siluera, and Hector Siluera for receiving & concealing stolen property after they tried to sell \$100,000 worth of stolen aircraft radio equipment.

② Background info - DOB - 14 March 19<sup>18?</sup> PUB: Cuba.

Arrived in US at Port Everglades, Fla. on 10 April 1959. Left U.S. on 8 April 1961, arrived US again on 9 Sept 1961 at New York City. Issued Re-Entry Permit in March 1962 for travel to Congo. U.S. Congressman Dante Fascell introduced a bill in Congress in June 1963 "to restore U.S. citizenship" to Whitehouse; that subject took part in "Bay of Pigs invasion"; that he contracted in 1961 to "fly for the United Nations in the Congo". He was associated with Liberal Party in Cuba 1937-59. Received Re-Entry Permit in Dec 1963 for travel to Mexico. INS File # A-11 241 940. Whitehouse was represented by Attorney Monroe Gelb. On March 5, 1962 Re-entry permit, Whitehouse listed his employer as L.B. Smith Aircraft Corporation, Miami, Fla.

In Feb 1964 - Whitehouse resided in Miami

In June 1964 - " " in Dallas (6141 Oram St.)

In Oct 1964 " " in Miami.

Employment in June 1964 was with RANSA Airlines, Miami.
