4 June 64 DDP 4-2844 To Rankin from Helms
Press has alleged that Soviet Intel or sabotage
training school in Munich. Also informed
inquiry from member of the Commission, Dull.

No had info regarding such training in
Munich since 1947 as reported by a
Soviet defector. Information from one
source since 1959 has not mentioned, confirmed
or corroborated the continued existence of
the installation

There was sabotage school there that functioned
until German attack on S. U in 1941 after
which moved to Leningrad.

There are only clues of info in CIA possession
re Munich training center

US which she said was sent to
her by an American in return for money
she lent him when he was visiting
S. U + ran short of funds

CIA believes proper transliteration of
her name is Zmitrook

CIA asks DIR to check whether can identify
the American who ran short of funds
& borrowed money from Zmitrook
Also ask Embassy if have any other
info on Zmitrook
