Employee [REDACTED] was the outside man who ran this base.

[BLAIR] [REDACTED] said that there was some other type of [REDACTED] operation in that base but he does not remember any details about it.

[BLAIR] [REDACTED] picked up the production from this base and turned it over to [REDACTED]

Mr. [REDACTED] said that the main thing to remember about the Mexico station was that it was very busy and active, and was almost entirely concerned with counter-intelligence.

[REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] was "a major cog" in the [Technical] operations in Mexico. He worked outside as a supply and fix-it man. He was involved in all the [Technical] operations.

BLAIR [REDACTED] was not sure but he thought that [REDACTED]

Employee's

[REDACTED] was [REDACTED] brother-in-law. He also thought that [REDACTED] AGENT had been involved in some kind of surveillance operation.

BLAIR [redacted] said that Min Scott was a "great manager" who was "hyper-dedicated and very demanding." He said that Min Scott's files were probably better than anything I had heard about them. He said that Scott had a very efficient registry system for the files. He said that the files were easy to work with and were extensive. He said that Scott would not tolerate incompetence or lack of thoroughness.

BLAIR [redacted] said that [redacted] was a "gal who did everything" she was a hard worker, very competent, who helped everyone.

BLAIR [redacted] said that [redacted] was the Soviet
