Raymond said that, in his interrogation of Charles, Duvalier appeared primarily concerned w/ determining if Charles had served as a funding channel from Cuban businessmen to Haitian conspirators. In the course of the conversation Duvalier showed Charles a photocopy of a passbook check for \$170,000 drawn in Charles name. Charles allegedly replied that he had dealings w/ many foreigners + Haitians. He denied Duvalier charges saying that, if he had been involved, it would have been a purely Haitian affair + he would not sully Haiti's honor by seeking help from foreigners.

Following our receipt of info that [redacted] had taken a list of requirements into the US Embassy in Port au Prince & asked help in fulfilling them, WH Dir. sent a memo on 19 Aug. 1969 to the Chief DC asking DC's contact w/ Louis H. Brun (from whom Charles received the requirements) be terminated.

The DC's NY office on 29 Aug. 1969 sent a memo to Sup Chief DC's which reviewed the case noted Brun had been guilty of sloppy security & concluded that no further requirements would be given him. This memo did not, however, say that contact would be terminated, in fact, it said they would continue to debrief Brun whenever he returned from a trip to Haiti. [The Station] ²⁸ repl.
