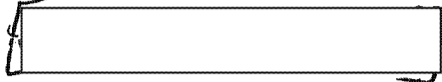

It is expected that his employment by the Agency will continue as long as the present government in Cuba is in existence. If the CASTRO Government were overthrown in favor of a non-Communist form of government and Subject's usefulness to CIA were obvious, the Agency would assist him in gaining employment with American firms, with business associations, with outlets or firms in Latin and Central America where he could use his native language and knowledge of Latin American and other matters. 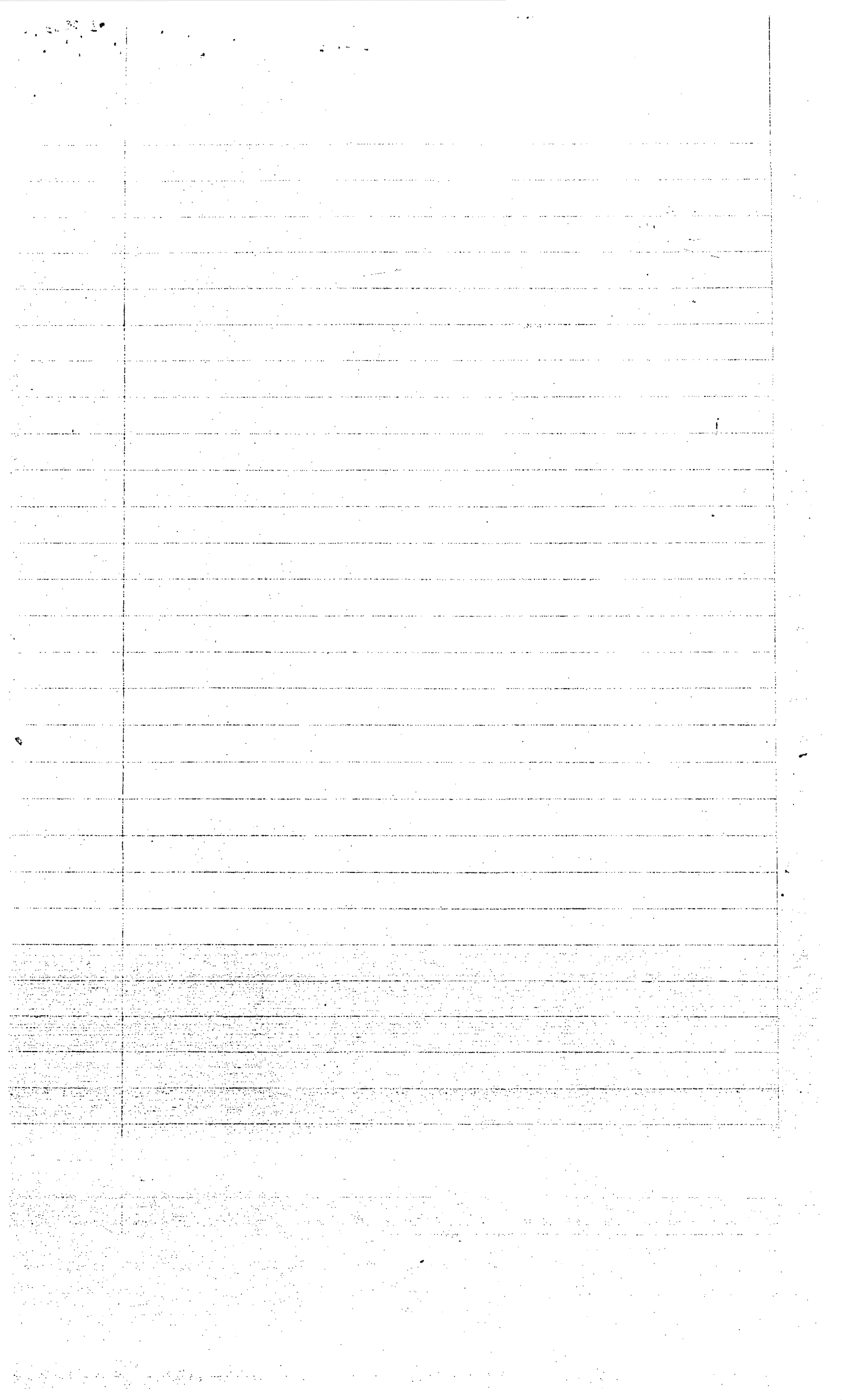
