AFTER THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY, THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF THE NETHERLANDS REACTED TO THE NEWS OF LEE OSWALD'S COMMUNIST SYMPATHIES IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: A DETAIL OF 30 MEN WAS ESTABLISHED TO GUARD, OVER THE COURSE OF THE 23 TO 24 NOVEMBER WEEKEND, THE PARTY'S FELIX MERITIS HEADQUARTERS BUILDING.

2. ON 25 NOVEMBER 1963 THE GUARD WAS WITHDRAWN AND THE DUTCH FLAG WAS FLOWN AT HALF MAST.
