As you are aware, by the letter to the Attorney General from G. Robert Blakey, dated June 2, 1978, all material on five individuals including John R. Kauffman, Beulah Kauffman and Dr. Hugh W. Maxey, was requested. With respect to FBINQ material on these three individuals, please refer to the FBI memorandum dated June 12, 1978, in which it is stated that no identifiable information was located.

A search for material in the field office which covers Jefferson County, Missouri (Kansas City Field Office), revealed one reference to John R. Kauffman in the case entitled "John R. Kauffman; AFA; OO:KC". This file has been processed and is available for review at FRINQ. It should be noted that although Kansas City indices are negative for Beulah Kauffman, she is mentioned in serial three of above-referenced file.

Based upon the information furnished by the Committee, no identifiable information was located in Kansas City Field Office files for Dr. Hugh W. Maxey.
