It is to be noted that there have been reports that subject is to be the Cuban Military Attaché in Madrid, although [redacted] advises that [redacted] Spanish Government has received no notification of the designation of subject as the Cuban Military Attaché here. [redacted] did advise that he had received information from [redacted] that the latter had been informed that CUBELA is to be the Cuban Military Attaché in Madrid.

Two extra copies of this letter are attached for forwarding by the Bureau to Havana. Havana is requested to furnish any background readily available on the subject from its files and from established sources.

The Madrid Office will maintain this case in a pending status awaiting the reply from Havana.
