US Military Alerting System 2

1. On 8 March 1963, the President approved a comprehensive 3  
 US program dealing with the movement of subversives and subversive 4  
 trainees to and from Cuba. 5

2. One of the recommendations approved by the President 6  
 proposed the establishment of a US military alerting system by 7  
 intelligence of subversive movement will be rapidly 8  
 to countries concerned. 9

3. It is requested that CINCARIB and CINCLANT take the 10  
 following actions to implement the approved recommendation: 11

a. Establish a military alerting system as quickly as 12  
 possible. 13

b. Expedite installation of the planned communications 14  
 circuits which were listed in reference. 15

c. Coordinate closely with CIA field offices to facilitate 1  
arrangements for intelligence inputs and for the use of CIA 2  
communications for emergency transmissions. 3

d. Dispatch messages on subversive movements directly 4  
to the Ambassadors concerned through the resident executive 5  
agent attache with a copy to DIA and other interested agencies. 6  
The requirement for timely transmittal is of paramount 7  
importance. Gp-1. 8
