While reviewing FBI files, I encountered a reference to the source mentioned in a 18 October 1960 ^{FBI} memorandum relating the conversation where Sam Giancana describes a plot to kill Castro. ~~Just~~ The source was a ~~person~~ boyfriend of one of the McGuire sisters; not Phyllis. The conversation occurred in New York City, at a restaurant, with Giancana, the two McGuire sisters, and the boyfriend present.
