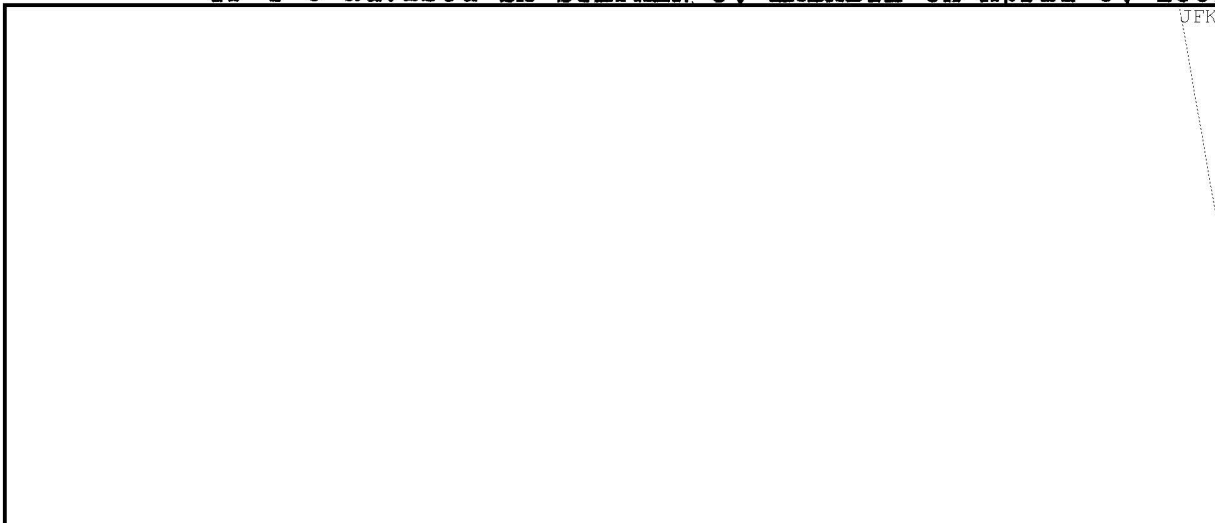
TP T-2 advised SANSTEPHEN J. LABADIE on April 6, 1961, that his source indicated that subject resided in Miami, Florida, that he visited Tampa infrequently, and that on the first occasion he would go to Miami and endeavor to locate subject. On April 11 this source reported that he was in Miami, Florida, and had been unable to locate subject's residence. On April 12, 1961, TP T-2 advised that although he did not see the subject in Miami, Florida, he last knew subject to hang out at the Italian restaurant around the 6800 block of Collins Avenue on Miami Beach and noted that he had in the past seen JAMES C. LONGO, also known as JIMMY, a close friend of the subject, and CASIMIRO HERNANDEZ, JR., also known as "CASEY" owner of Columbia Restaurant, Tampa, both in the general vicinity of Miami Beach.
