ADMINISTRATIVE

Chicago source CG 9561-PC, advised on January 19, 1973, that during recent conversation with MARSHALL CAIFANO, after CAIFANO's release from prison and prior to his Palm Springs vacation, CAIFANO stated that he was interested in contacting GUS ZAPAS. Apparently CAIFANO and ZAPAS are associated in shaking down Local 46 of the Laundry Workers Union. From the informant's impression, ZAPAS owes CAIFANO money. On inquiry, informant stated he determined GUS ZAPAS was in Las Vegas and was visiting his brother who was reportedly seriously ill.
